- 1 five-gallon bucket with lid

- Scrub Brush

- 2 large trash bags (3 mil)
- 1 roll paper towels
- Comet or scouring cleanser
- Pine Sol or liquid cleaner
- 1 pair rubber gloves size L
- 1 pair leather gloves size L
- 1 pair cotton gloves size L

What's in a Health Care Kit?

(Please pack in a 2-gallon plastic storage bag or tote bag)

- 1 bath towel
- 1 wash cloth (optional)
- 1 shampoo (2 if travel size)
- 1 bar of soap (2 if travel size)
- 1 toothbrush (individually sealed)
- 1 pack of dental floss (optional)
- 1 toothpaste (2 if travel size)
- 1 comb
- 1 deodorant
- 1 nail clippers (optional)
