I have a meeting & I'm not sure where it is. What do all of these initials mean?

CH = Choir Room (near nursery)

CR = Conference Room (located in the office building)

FH = Fellowship Hall (downstairs from the Sanctuary, off the main hallway in the middle of the campus)

GR = Gathering Room (in the back of the PLC near the kitchen-has comfy furniture)

PLC = Parish Life Center (at the opposite end from the Sanctuary—the big room with all the windows)
